Summary

The project wants to identify, analyse and raise awareness about the barriers in public transport for people with disabilities in Toruń, engaging them and their community in citizen science activities. It aims to study accessibility gaps in the public transport in Toruń, to provide the city authorities with data, illustrating the levels of satisfaction of passengers with disabilities (PwD) from using public transport. The overall goal is to help the local transport authority in accommodating the needs of people with disabilities in the day-to-day functioning of mobility services. We will expand on the outputs of TRIPS, an H2020 project on inclusive public transport, notably the Mobility Divide Index and the accompanying app and toolkit. In addition to fostering CS awareness and engagement in Poland, we also plan to address the general need for making CS itself more inclusive, not least by involving PwD as active researchers.
